

Acceptable Service Learning Activities

- Homeless Shelters
- Churches and Ceremonial grounds (Working in the nursery, cleaning up the church or ceremonial grounds)
- Humane Societies (Walking the animals, cleaning)
- Working concession stands (Non-Paid)
- Firework stands (Non-paid)
- Baby Sitting (Non-paid)
- Picking up trash (Non-paid)
- Yard Work (Non-Paid)
- Participating in fundraising events and activities (bake sale, car wash, etc.)
- Setting up and or cleaning up for community, school, church events and activities.
- Creating a service learning project such as: creating an awareness project, a book drive, food drive, clothing drive, etc.

Non-Acceptable Service Learning Activities

- Household chores (Cleaning the house, making bed, dishes, walking/feeding the family pet, etc.)
- Participating in the opportunity that the grant is used for such as: games, tournaments, practices, classes, lessons of any sort, sporting, rodeo, band, etc.
- Anyone living in the household CANNOT sign off on the service learning log.
- If youth is getting compensated for their service of any sort, then it will NOT count towards their required hours.
